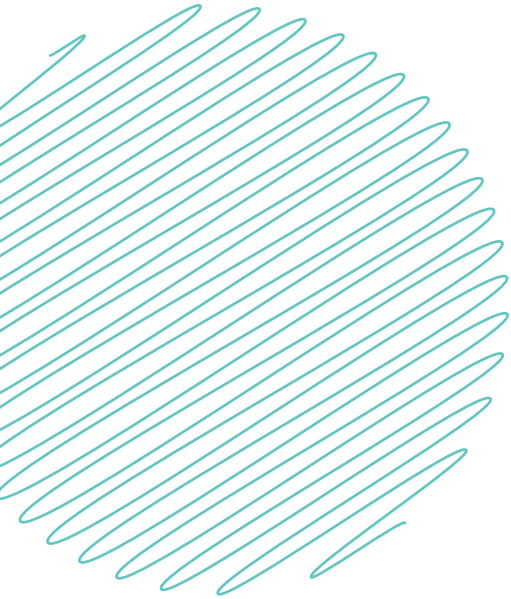

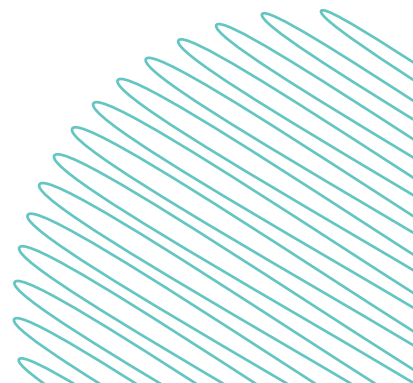

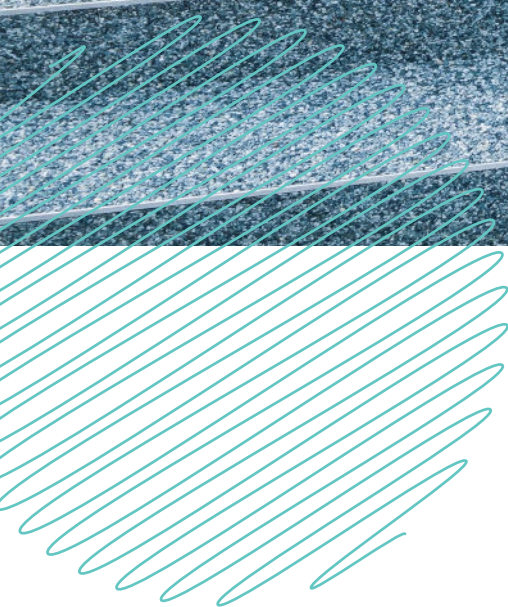

With long life and minimal maintenance, it is no wonder it's one of the bestselling concrete products on the market.

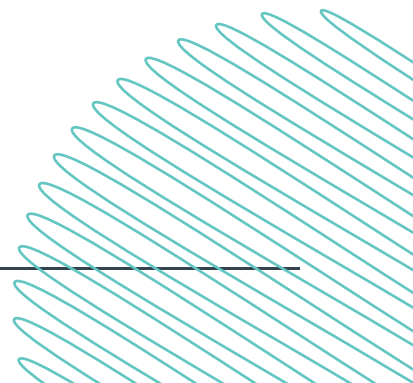

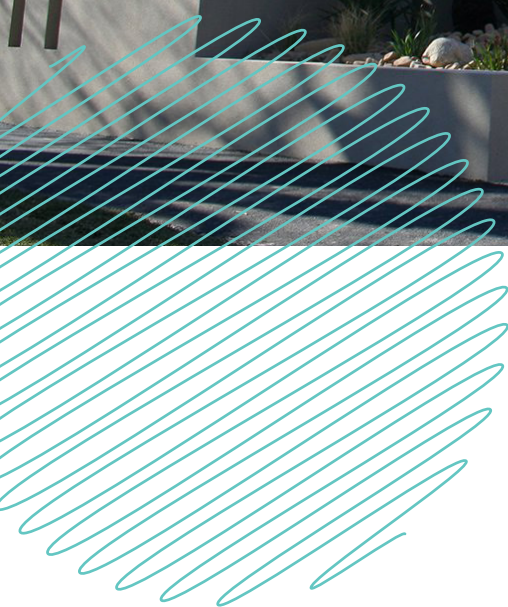

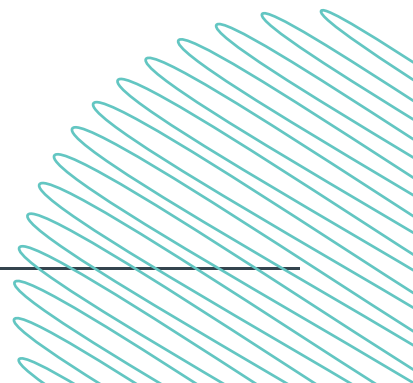

FAQs

What is the Difference Between Honed and Polished Concrete?

Many flooring contractors use the terminology incorrectly when describing concrete flooring solutions. The terms “honed” concrete and “polished” concrete can be used interchangeably as can “honed” concrete and “grind and seal” concrete. Honed concrete and polished concrete flooring solutions both involve the mechanical processing of an existing concrete surface by means of cutting and/or refining to a desired finish.

How do I know what type of concrete to use?

To know the use or function of the concrete is important, the mix-design of concrete that is used for footings would be different to that of a house slab, a driveway or even pre-cast panels.

How much concrete do I need for my job?

Every job is different, however if you follow some basic rules it is easy to get an idea of how much concrete you will need. Concrete is purchased by the cubic meter (m³) and is placed by the square meter (m²). For normal household concrete the depth or thickness of the concrete is 10cm or 100mm. That is for every m³ of concrete 10m² is placed.

How long does the concrete take to set?

Generally the product can be walked on after 24 hours and driven on after 7 days.

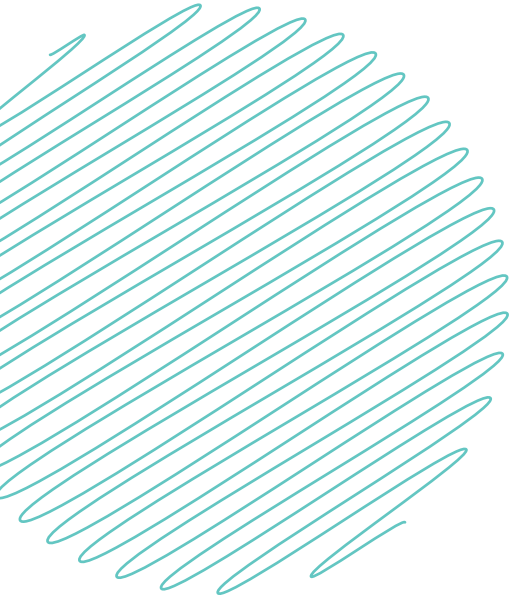
Can I choose various colours?
